

LICENSE AGREEMENT

The original imagery from SPOT satellites was made available by the CNES SPOT World Heritage Programme (<https://regards.cnes.fr/html/swh/Home-sw3.html>). Google wishes to acknowledge the assistance of Airbus SA in processing these images to create the Brazil Forest Imagery Dataset 2008. Your use of the Brazil Forest Imagery Dataset 2008 is subject to the terms of this license agreement (the “**License Agreement**”).

PURPOSE	The purpose of this License is to provide you with access to Brazil Forest Imagery Dataset (the “Content”) for the purpose of reducing and reversing the loss of tropical forests, combating climate change, conserving biodiversity, contributing to forest regrowth, restoration and enhancement, and facilitating sustainable development.

RESTRICTIONS AND OBLIGATIONS	You will not distribute the Brazil Forest imagery Dataset 2008 on a standalone basis. Any derivative work you create must have independent value. You must provide attribution.

LICENSE AGREEMENT

YOUR USE OF THE BRAZIL FOREST IMAGERY DATASET 2008 IS SUBJECT TO THE TERMS OF THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT ("**LICENSE**").

1. Definitions

"**Content**" means Brazil Forest Imagery Dataset 2008.

"**Google**" means Google LLC with an address at 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway Mountain View, California 94043 USA.
