## The GSoC program is open to:

- Applicants must be 18 years or older.
- Students or beginners to open source (less than 2 years of experience in OSS)

## **Your GSoC Journey:**

- 1. Remote & Flexible: The program is entirely remote.
- 2. Duration: Contributors spend 12+ weeks coding on their chosen project.
- 3. Mentorship: Volunteer mentors guide you on best practices, community norms, and project-specific tools, helping you integrate into the community.
- 4. Stipend: Earn a stipend upon successful completion of project milestones.

By the end of their GSoC program, contributors receive an invaluable learning experience, an introduction to the global OSS community and something that potential employers love to see on resumes!

Mentor organizations will gain new contributions & contributors along with a higher visibility for their open source project.

Mentor organization applications are open January 19 - February 3, 2026. GSoC contributor applications are open March 16 - March 31, 2026.
